

## LET US GO ON HEBREWS 6

The book of Hebrews is a book that some people do read or interpret properly. I have heard so many statements about Heb. 6 until it amazes me. How can a lost person go anywhere but to repentance. May we look at a few things that we need to go on to.

1. “Let us Go On To Teaching”; Hebrews 5:11-14
  - a. Reason For Not Going On. Their diet was still weakening them. Heb. 5:13
  - b. Results. They needed taught again what they had already been taught.
  
2. “Let Us Go On To Truth”; Hebrews 5:14
  - a. Truth Of Discernment. This comes by going on in His word.
  - b. Truth Of Development. Eph. 4:14 should not be children tossed to and fro by every wind and doctrine.
  
3. “Let Us Go On To Transformation”; Romans 12:1-2
  - a. Transformed To Accept. This is the problem with these in Hebrews, they were not willing to go on and see Jesus the better way.
  - b. Transformed To Affirm. We do not go on to be saved but go on because we are saved. James says that faith without works is dead. In Hebrews 6 they were compelled to go. Go on to what? Later, it says the things that accompany salvation. How can this be said of the lost?
